Responsibilities

- Comply with Wesdome safety policies and applicable regulatory, customer or industry requirements.
- Participate in the development of safe work procedures.
- Participate in the planning, health and safety, or other meetings as required.
- Build strong relationships with Maintenance team to ensure smooth operations and satisfaction.
- Work in compliance with Health and Safety regulations and other applicable regulations (TSSA, CWB)
- Ensure all log books are maintained according to standard operating procedures.
- Repairing, installing/uninstalling, assembling/disassembling, aligning equipment as necessary, both mobile and stationary equipment.
- Perform pre-assembly activities such as cleaning and lubricating parts.
- Read and interpret blueprints, sketches and written instructions to assemble the parts or products.
- Perform heavy mobile mining equipment assembly according to engineering drawings.
- Position or align components for assembly, manually or using hoists.
- Follows scopes of work within time constraints.
- Reading and following blueprints/schematics.
- Conducting preventative maintenance checks on equipment.
- Use tools and equipment correctly and safely.
- Providing information on required parts and equipment to allow proper management of parts required for ordering.
