COMPANY INFORMATION

Wesdome Gold Mines is in its 30th year of continuous gold mining operations in Canada. The Company is 100% Canadian focused with a pipeline of projects in various stages of development. The Eagle River Complex is located approximately 50 km south of Highway 17 and 50 km West of Wawa, Ontario. We are currently producing gold from a central mill which processes ore from the Eagle River Underground Mine and the Mishi Open Pit Mine.

JOB DESCRIPTION & QUALIFICATIONS

Summary

The Environmental Technician is responsible for the environmental data review and compilation and reporting to comply with the Federal and Provincial regulations and the site policies at the Eagle River Mine Complex, which includes the Eagle Mine and Mill, the Mishi Open Pit and the Magnacon Mine (closed). The environmental technician reports to the Environmental Coordinator.

Responsibilities / Job Duties Performed

- Conduct compliance sampling and monitoring (surface and ground water quality, air quality, water flow using stream gauging equipment, water levels and sediment quality).
- Maintain year-to-year continuity in monitoring programs.
- Maintenance of environmental monitoring instruments and testing equipment.
- Monitor water levels in the ponds and ensure appropriate actions are taken (e.g. transfers of water between the Tails, Reclaim Pond, and Polishing Pond; necessary treatment of the water, and discharges ...).
- Review, compile, and consolidate all of the environmental data and communications.
- Prepare compliance and regulatory reports (daily, weekly, monthly and annual).
- Manage environmental databases.
- Participate in the completion of necessary documentation to obtain required permits, amendments and licenses.
- Participate in the environmental emergency response plan.
- Contribute to the ongoing reclamation and closure process.
- Airborne testing for silica, DPM and lead at the sites.

Qualifications

- Diploma/Degree in Natural/Earth Sciences or related Engineering discipline 2-5 years of environmental and mining related work experience
- Excellent knowledge of Municipal, Provincial (Ontario) and Federal Acts and Regulations.
- Good understanding of the mining and milling processes and their environmental effects
- Self-starter who is able to anticipate needs and work independently with minimal supervision
- The individual should have demonstrated a high level of energy, self motivation, and strong problem solving and organizational skills
- Good communication skills, both orally and written with both internal and external contacts and the ability to work with all levels of the organization.
- Proficiency in Microsoft Office programs is required.
- Proficiency in database programs would be an asset.
